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The tutoring activity as been conceived as “on the job training” at ISPRA in the area of regulatory licensing and oversight of decommissioning activities of NPP or other NF.

It will contribute to a real and practical “build-up” of knowledge allowing a sustainable transfer of approaches and methods.

The tutoring will start from the beginning of October lasting up to the end of November

The tutoring will include:

1. Participation to onsite inspections to get evidence of the complementarity between regulatory safety review and regulatory inspections.
2. Evidence of regulator’s licensing management capability, type and content of interfaces between regulator and applicant and between regulator and external technical support will be provided.
3. Familiarization with regulatory requirements and applicable standards.

Objective of the tutoring will be to ensure an optimum of transfer of know-how and develop capability to use it in the context of NRAs and TSOs functions, complementing the acquisition gained in the previous 2 weeks training course on the same theme.

The following general program will be followed.

Week 1: familiarization with ISPRA structures and organization: Illustration by the tutor of the ISPRA roles and activities in the field of decommissioning and waste management

Week 2: familiarization with regulatory requirements and applicable standards. Decommissioning plans and their status

Week 3: evaluation of Operator documents related to decommissioning planning. Issues encountered

Week 4: participation in Operator –NRA meetings: tentative meeting minutes

Week 5: participation to onsite inspections to get evidence of the complementarity between regulatory safety review and regulatory inspections.

Week 6: Preparation of a report on the performed activities

Week 7: presentation to ISPRA officers of the performed activities

Week 8: final week – organization of the return and return party
