Draft Tutoring Program (main content)

The tutoring activity has been conceived as “on the job training” at ISPRA in the area of regulatory licensing and oversight of RW and decommissioning activities of NPP or other NF.

It will contribute to a real and practical “build-up” of knowledge allowing a sustainable transfer of approaches and methods.

The tutoring will start from the beginning of June lasting up to the end of July 2013

After an initial presentation of main aspect of RW Management and decommissioning of nuclear facilities by experts from ISPRA and with contribution from ITER, the tutoring will include:

1. Participation to onsite inspections to get evidence of the complementarity between regulatory safety review and regulatory inspections.
2. Evidence of regulator’s licensing management capability, type and content of interfaces between regulator and applicant and between regulator and external technical support will be provided.
3. Familiarization with regulatory requirements, applicable standards and international references.

Objective of the tutoring will be to ensure an optimum of transfer of know-how and develop capability to use it in the context of NRAs and TSOs functions, complementing the acquisition gained in the previous 2 weeks training course on the same theme.

The tutoring activity will include site visits to Italian facilities for RW management and to nuclear sites under decommissioning.

A detailed program will be prepared later.
